### **Reimbursement Program**

Get your septic tank inspected, pumped, or minor repairs done up to \$800.

- Sign up for a SNA and complete at least one of the recommended practices.
- Ask your SNA team leader if you qualify for the reimbursement program.
- Fill out the reimbursement eligibility form.
- Wait to receive an email telling you that you are eligible.
- Get your septic tank inspected, pumped, or minor repairs done up to \$800.
- 6 Submit receipts to your SNA team leader.
- Receive a reimbursement check for up to \$800 in the mail within 30 days.
